IV. — In case default shall be made by the party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, in any of the conditions above stipulated to be performed by him it shall and may be lawful for the party of the first part, if he see fit, to declare this Contract void, and to re-enter upon the said premises at any time after such default, without serving on the party of the second part, or any person holding under him, a notice to quit said Land.
