"Hero's Moon" by Marion Zimmer Bradley. Realistic drama on an uninhabitable world. Not the sort of thing Bradley does well.

"Where the Woodbine Twineth" by Manly Wade Wellman. Love, betrayal and witchcraft in the Southern mountains. There's nothing new here, and for once that's praise: every element is a familiar theme of Anglo-American ballads (Considering that the Southern mountains are among the places these ballads have lasted longest; and that Wellman has used folksongs in a number of stories; this is almost certainly deliberate.)

"The Ladies of Beetlegoose Nine" by R. Bretnor. A Papa Schimmelhorn story. If you enjoy these (I liked only the first), you'll like this one. If you've found even one of the series tedious, skip this one.

"Science" by Isaac Asimov. A reasonable good explanation of quasars.

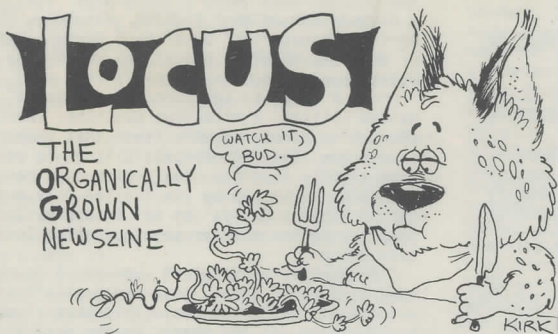
