Camp Vermont

November 9th 1862

Dear Brother I now
take this opportunity to write
a few lines to you to day
the wether is cold day before
yestady it snowed all day it

ground now our house was

the morning we started after
a stove we hunted all round
and we come acrossed a old shanty
he had one we gave a half
a dollar for it

it is nice itel you I wish
you cud just come in to
and haure and se us we sluk
more like hogs then eny thing
else we went up to the
cookers tent and there was a
nice pere of beef there we
took it and went to the tent
and fried it i found a haf of
a canten it makes us a nice
frying panol if we stay here
nine monthes we shant no
how to set down to a table
to eat a mel of vitels
but then iges we cud make
a hole into it I ges I ingong
my self tip top I am tuf
and rugged I tel you what it
is the niggers are beter of
then we are I ~~would~~ wouldnt
giv farther farm afo al
I ren renre I come down
here.

tel farther that I hope
he wil come down here
this winter it wont cost
but thirty dollars you wont
never begate it in the world
I made to wrings one for mother
and the other for Elizabeth
I made it with my nife the one with
the hart is mothers if you wil
send me some ranset paper i
wil make you one it is made
of laurel rut there is plenty
here tel farther to send
me some torteg stant for i
am out of them i wish you
would tel me when our mon
more monthes comence

take good care of Harley

I cant think of
any more now and so
good bye
