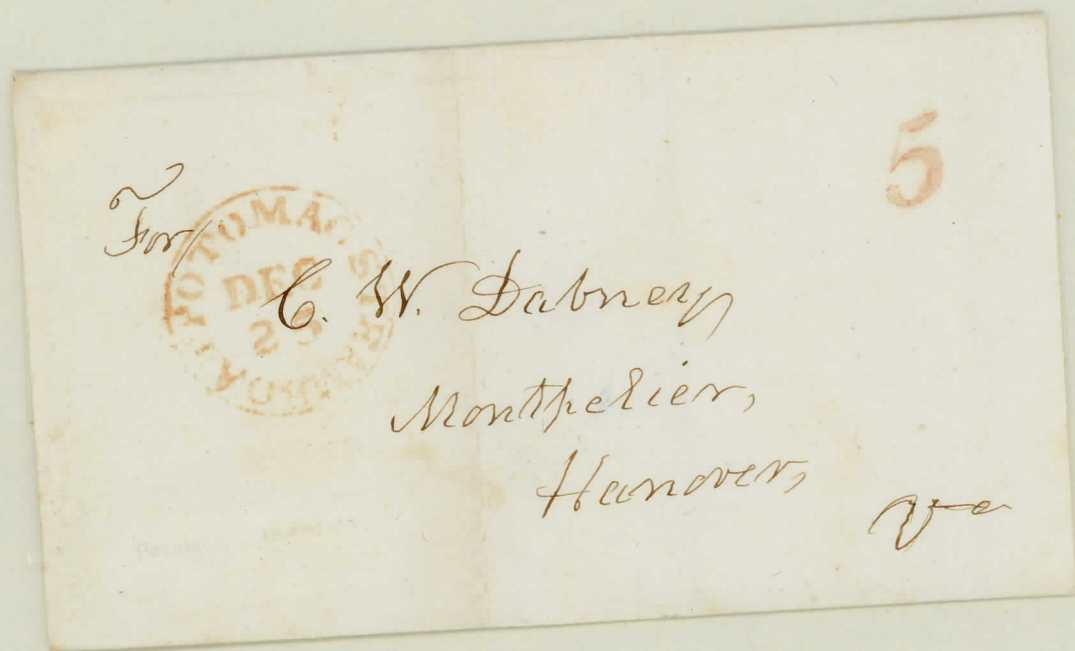

GIVEN IN PHILADELPHIA TO BLOOD'S PENNY POST ON
17 JANUARY WHO GAVE IT TO THE RAILWAY ROUTE AGENT
WHO IN TURN CARRIED IT THROUGH TO WASHINGTON, D.C.
AND GAVE IT TO POSTAL CLERK ABOARD POTOMAC
STEAMBOAT.

THE 3c WASHINGTON (#11) WAS ISSUED IN 1851 AND WAS REPLACED
IN 1857. THE BLUE BLOOD'S PENNY POST (#15L15) WAS ISSUED
IN 1856
