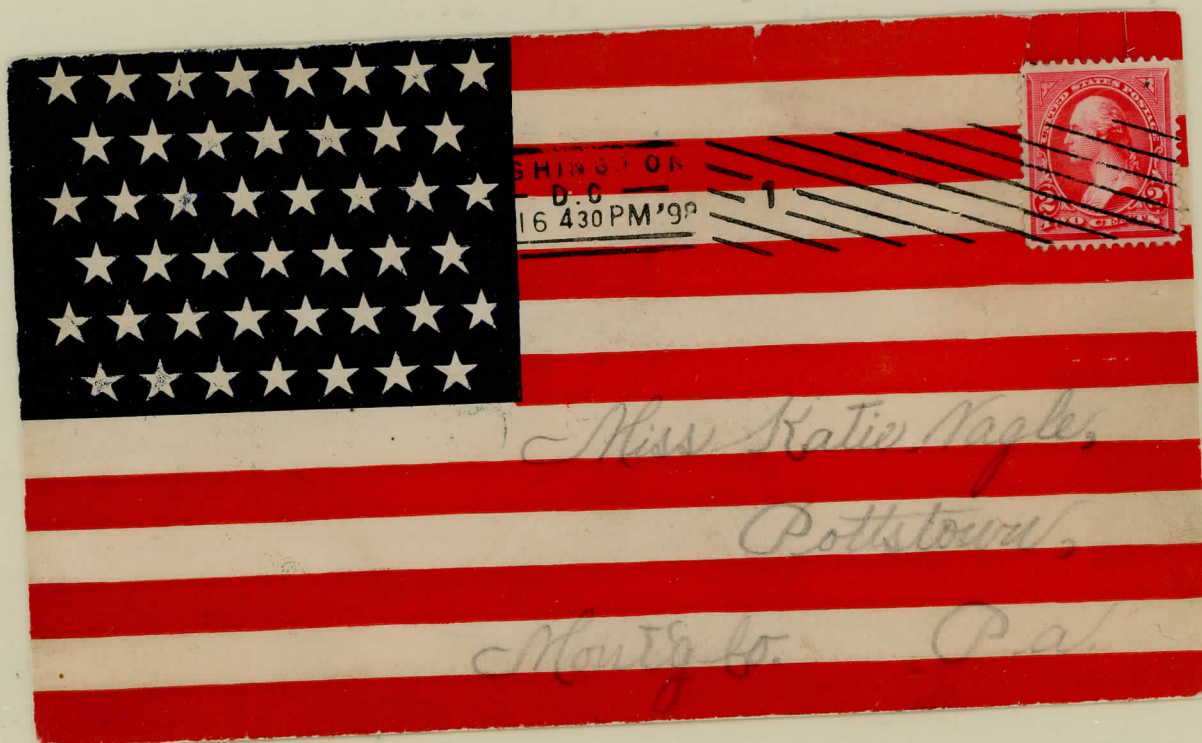

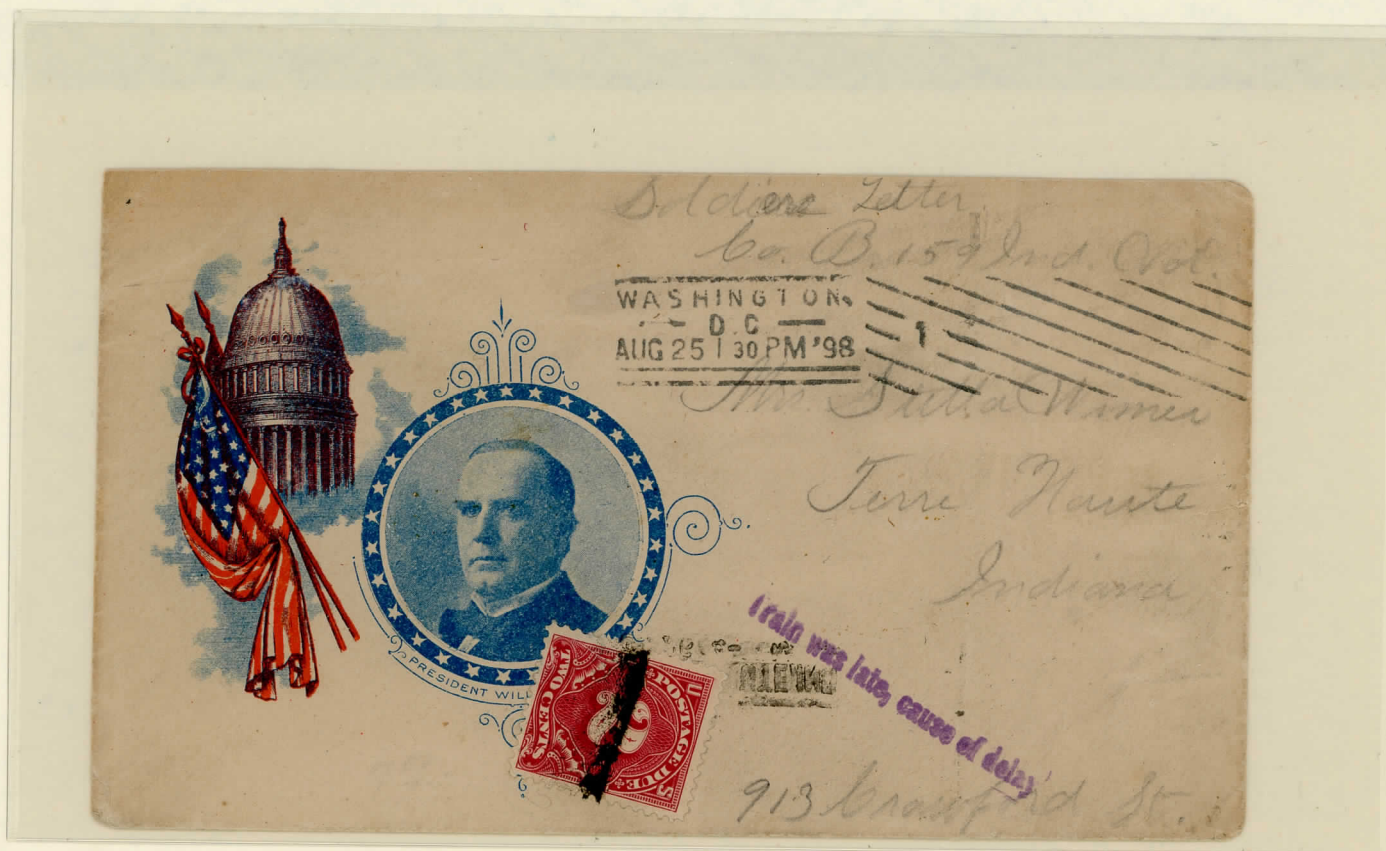

SOLDIER'S LETTER ROUTED THROUGH WASHINGTON, DC TO TERRA HAUTE, INDIANA, 25 AUGUST 1898, WITH UNUSUAL "TRAIN WAS LATE, CAUSE OF DELAY" HANDSTAMP

THE 159TH INDIANA VOLUNTEER INFANTRY WAS MUSTERED INTO FEDERAL SERVICE ON 12 MAY 1898 AT CAMP MOUNT IN INDIANAPOLIS. ON 15 MAY THE 159TH AND OTHER INDIANA UNITS WERE ORDERED TO CAMP THOMAS, GEORGIA. THE CAMP WAS LOCATED ON THE CIVIL WAR BATTLEFIELD OF CHICKAMAUGA. THE UNIT STAYED AT FORT THOMAS ONLY A SHORT TIME BEFORE BEING ORDERED TO PORT TAMPA, FLORIDA. THE 159TH ARRIVED AT PORT TAMPA ON 3 JUNE WHERE IT REMAINED UNTIL 30 AUGUST.

PORT TAMPA WAS THE EMBARKATION POINT FOR TROOPS BEING SENT TO CUBA. BUT, THE 159TH NEVER EMBARKED FOR CUBA OR PORTO RICO. WITH AN ARMISTICE DECLARED ON 12 AUGUST 1898, THE 159TH WAS SENT BACK TO CAMP MOUNT IN INDIANAPOLIS AND FINALLY MUSTERED OUT OF SERVICE ON 4 NOVEMBER 1898.

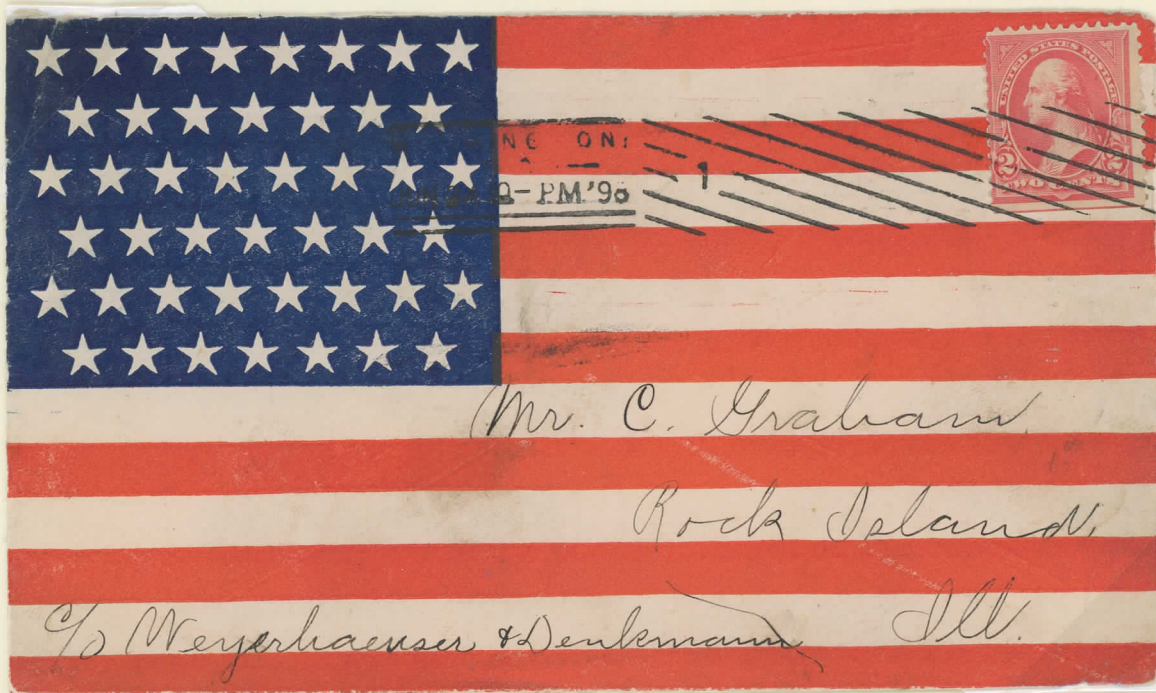


BARR-FYKE MACHINE CANCELLATION 18 JULY 1898

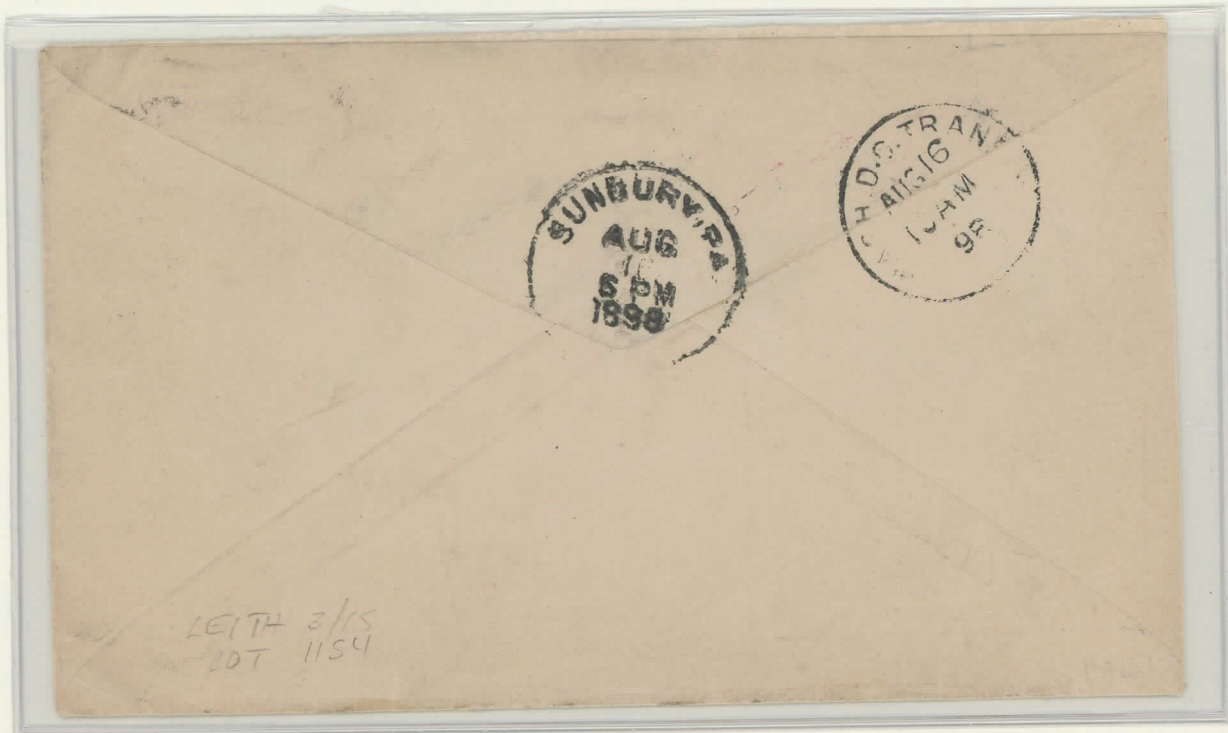

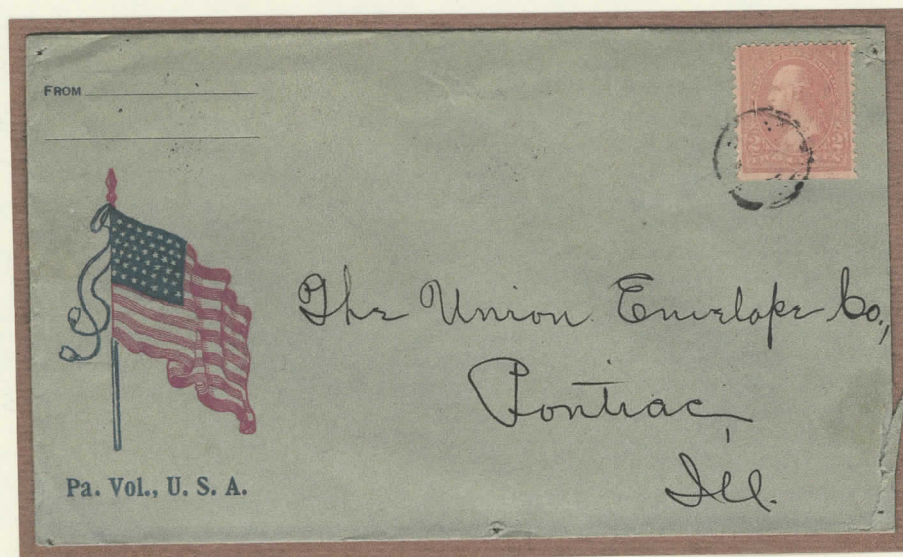
CIVIL WAR PATRIOTIC ENVELOPE USED DURING
SPANISH-AMERICAN WAR FROM CORNITH



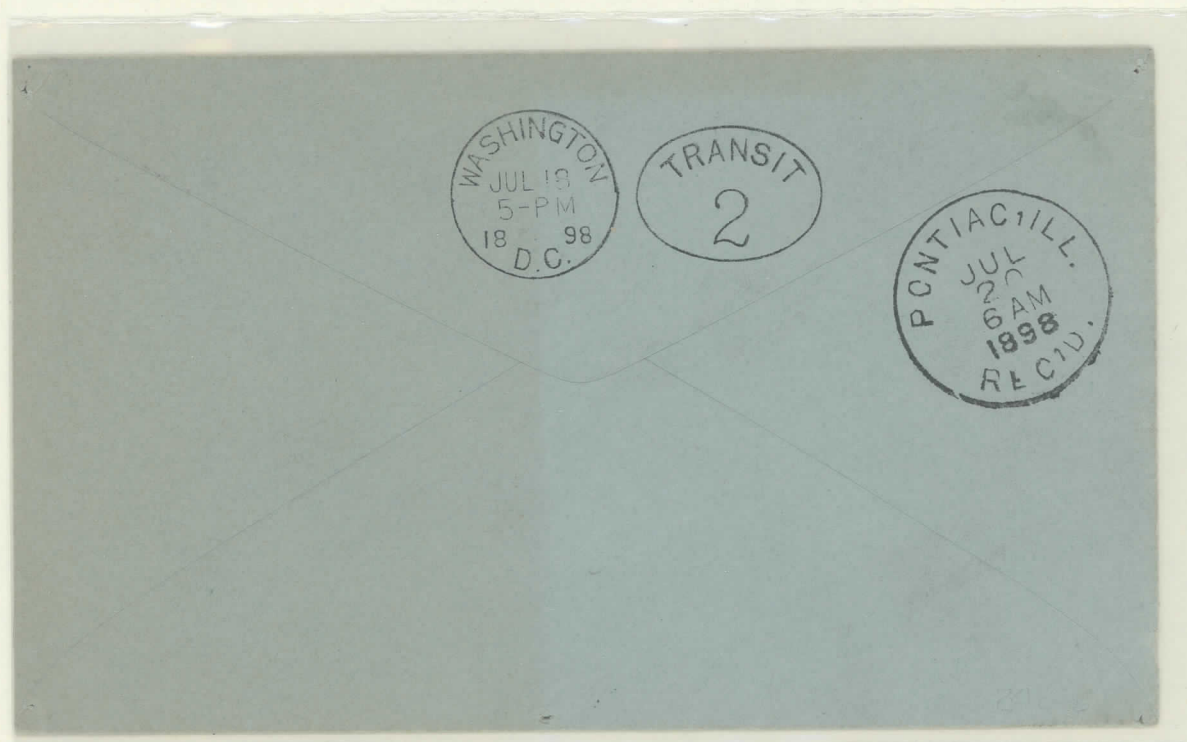

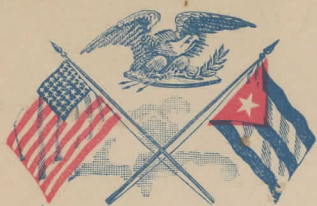
PHOTOCOPY OF ADDRESS SIDE AT 75% OF

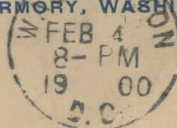
